ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

ON THE ADDITION OF MORE GROWLERS IS NOW AVAILABLE

The Navy Whidbey DRAFT EIS is now available - all 1500 pages. Hard copies are located at the Libraries on Lopez, San Juan and Orcas Islands. To access the Draft EIS online, go to http://www.whidbeyeis.com/

WHAT IS THIS DRAFT EIS ABOUT? The Navy plans to add 35 or 36 more Growlers to the Naval Air Station on Whidbey Island. Our community comments from 2014 are considered in this EIS.

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT SAN JUAN COUNTY? The Navy estimates a 46-47% increase in Growler traffic in our area.

DO OUR COMMENTS MATTER? They do. In the event of future lawsuits our written comments give us standing or the right to participate in the proceedings.
